## NEVADA ASSEMBLY MAJORITY LEADER SANDRA JAUREGUI INTRODUCES LEGISLATION TO BRING FILM INDUSTRY AND WORKFORCE TRAINING PROGRAM TO NEVADA

Jauregui Submitted Bill Draft Request of The Nevada Studio Infrastructure, Jobs and
Workforce Training Act to Advance Project in 2025 Legislative Session

Today, Assembly Majority Leader Sandra Jauregui submitted a bill draft request to the Legislative Counsel Bureau to introduce **The Nevada Studio Infrastructure**, **Jobs and Workforce Training Act** during the 2025 Legislative Session to build a Las Vegas-based production studio and workforce training program. Assemblywoman Jauregui's bill would focus on the construction of the Summerlin® Production Studios, as well as modernizing the existing Nevada Film Tax Credit program and building a workforce training program to ensure that the next generation of film leaders come from Nevada.

Since the end of the 2023 Legislative Session, stakeholders have continued policy discussions and undertaken economic studies to determine the right contours of a bill. Based on those discussions, the **Nevada Studio Infrastructure**, **Jobs and Workforce Training Act** is expected to create nearly 20,000 construction jobs, 15,000 annual jobs upon completion and an annual economic impact of \$2.85 billion a year to Las Vegas' economy. Importantly, most of these jobs will be union jobs with six-figure salaries.

"The Nevada Studio Infrastructure, Jobs and Workforce Training Act is an incredibly exciting opportunity to transform our economy," said Assembly Majority Leader Sandra Jauregui. "Not only will this create nearly 20,000 construction jobs, 15,000 annual jobs and billions of dollars in annual economic activity - it will help expand Las Vegas' global image as the entertainment capital of the world. This bill will bring together community partners, union leaders and elected officials to build these studios and create high quality, six-figure union jobs."

"The members of the Southern Nevada Building Trades Unions thank Assemblywoman Jauregui for bringing this bill and look forward to welcoming the film industry to Nevada," said **Southern Nevada Build Trades Executive Secretary-Treasurer Vince Saavedra.** "Large-scale projects, like the partnership between Howard Hughes, developer of the Summerlin® master planned community, and Sony Pictures Entertainment, will create thousands of jobs that are covered by our PLA partnership and provide good wages and benefits to our State."
